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REVITAL, READY FOR PILOTING!

The project "REVITAL: Socioeconomic revitalization of low-density population areas through clinical telecare", which is part of the Interreg VI-B Sudoe 2021 – 2027 Program, begins in 2025 ready to start the piloting of the project.

In the three entities where the pilot project is being carried out —Fundación San Cebrián (Spain), EPS GARAZI (France) and IPCB (Portugal)— steps are being taken to begin personalized treatment with patients, including the use of technology to obtain their data.

Piloting in 2025

Fundación San Cebrián (FSC), a Palencia-based entity that is part of the REVITAL Project, led by the SIVI Cluster, has shown itself ready for the pilot phase that will start in January 2025. Last Friday, December 13, Fundación San Cebrián held an informative session on the REVITAL Project at the 'Ángel Aguado' Open Space in Villamuriel de Cerrato, which included a practical part in which attendees were able to learn about support technologies for better understanding; technologies that will be used in the piloting of the project.



The main objective of REVITAL is to cover the need to provide specialized health care and physical and neurological rehabilitation services (especially for dependent and elderly people), through technological tools that allow the provision of tele-assistance and telerehabilitation services, which will also contribute to creating qualified employment and establishing a new population that will boost the rural economy.

REVITAL PILOTAGE DURING 2025

The pilot project is being carried out by three entities, one for each country. The Castelo Branco Polytechnic Institute (IPCB) will carry it out in Portugal, EPS Garazi in France, and the San Cebrián Foundation itself in Spain. Thus, the San Cebrián Foundation (FSC) will begin the pilot with patients this January. A phase that will run throughout 2025, ending in December.

FSC reported that the pilot project will be carried out with a minimum of 5 and a maximum of 25 volunteers in the Cerrato and Tierra de Campos area. To date, a total of 20 applications for participation have been received from patients with Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS), Multiple Sclerosis (MS), Stroke, Parkinson's and other pathologies. Once the application has been submitted, the professionals will assess the people who are suitable to continue in the project.

During this session, FSC first presented the project and its beneficiaries, reporting on the technologies that will be used for the first phase of the pilot, some of which have been funded by the University of Deusto, another entity in the consortium.

The FSC physiotherapists in charge of the pilot tested the use of the technology with the participants and stressed that their work with the patients will consist of carrying out a "normal treatment", in which "these technologies will be included":



- **Viltalstim Plus**: electrotherapy system used for the treatment of people with dysphagia and head and neck disorders.
- **Fesia walk**: system for limb rehabilitation II through muscle stimulation, promoting dorsal flexion, plantar flexion, inversion and eversion.
- **Pablo**: Multifunctional rehabilitation equipment for upper and lower limbs, trunk and neck. To train movement and strength control deficits, precision, aim, coordination, trunk control and balance.
- **Tymo**: Posturography system. Works on balance, postural control, muscle strength, core stability and reduces the risk of falls through a balance platform.
- **Mobi**: A device that actively and passively mobilizes upper and lower extremities to develop muscles, restore joint movement and improve cardiovascular function.
- **Rehametrics**: physical and cognitive rehabilitation software. Through Virtual Reality and movement analysis, balance, joint range of upper and lower limbs, movement, coordination, body control and resistance are worked on.

CASTELO BRANCO, WITNESS TO THE PROGRESS OF REVITAL

On 20 and 21 November, the Portuguese town of Castelo Branco hosted the new follow-up meeting of the REVITAL project, Socio-economic revitalization of low-density population areas through clinical telecare. The meeting of the 9 members of the consortium in charge of implementing the project took place at the Polytechnic Institute of Castelo Branco (IPCB) and the Associação Empresarial da Beira Baixa (AEBB), headquarters of the two Portuguese entities that are part of REVITAL.



Thus, the REVITAL project showed in Castelo Branco the new advances that the entities of each of the three countries (Portugal, Spain and France) are working on together. Among them, the launch of a new offer of physiotherapists, the assessment of potential patients before the end of the year and the start of the pilot in January 2025, which represent some of the most relevant milestones that have been achieved, and others that are expected for the coming months, stood out.

On Wednesday, November 20, the members of the consortium that make up this European project met for the first day that started at the facilities of ESALD – Escola Superior de Saúde Dr. Lopes Dias, of the Polytechnic Institute of Castelo Branco, where we visited the center, the place where the pilot project will be carried out, and we addressed key issues in the development of new technologies and their application for physiotherapy.





On the second day, held on Thursday 21 November, the consortium moved to the of AEBB headquarters Associação Empresarial Beira Baixa, where Sónia Azevedo, deputy director of the entity, welcomed us and showed us a video where we were able to learn more about the facilities, the mission and the work carried out at AEBB. The meeting continued with perspectives from invited experts from Castilla y León, the definition of different business models of the three pilot cases and the presentation of the Communication strategy, among other fundamental issues.


CLUSTER SIVI | VALLADOLID, SPAIN
