ERDF programme to address the common challenges faced by the SUDOE regions—climate change, social cohesion, and territorial balance—through cooperation projects between entities in the Member States that make up this area.

26 regions and 68,2 million inhabitants.

2021-2027 period budget: 115.3 million euros.
